

Call for Tutorials

All IECON-2008 and ICELIE-2008 attendees are welcome to attend any of the tutorials at no additional charge. Tutorials are expected to be 3 hours 20 minutes in duration, on the morning of Monday, 10 November. (Tentatively, tutorials will start at 8 a.m. and conclude at 11:40 a.m., with a 20 minute break from 9:40-10 a.m.)

Attendees will be asked to register (no fee) so that conference organizers may allocate sufficient materials and seating. Tutorials registration will be performed online as part of the conference registration process.

Persons wishing to develop and present a tutorial should submit a proposal in PDF format to *both* Tutorials Co-Chairs, no later than 1 May 2008. Proposals should include:

- Tutorial Title
- Presenter(s) contact information
 - Contact Person:
 - *name*
 - *affiliation*
 - *mailing address*
 - *telephone and fax numbers*
 - *e-mail address*
 - Other presenters. For each presenter, include the following information:
 - *name*
 - *affiliation*
 - *e-mail address*
- Abstract (Description)
 - 500 word limit. If the tutorial is accepted, this abstract is the description that will be published in the conference program and proceedings. Please be sure the description is accurate.
- Presenter(s) background/biography
 - Please provide a brief biography addressing qualifications for presenting the proposed tutorial, including publications relevant to the tutorial
- Intended audience
 - For whom is this tutorial intended? Please describe the audience in terms of:
 - expected knowledge in the material: basic, medium, advanced
 - topics as listed in the conference call for papers: Controls, Power Electronics, etc.

Authors of accepted proposals will be notified in early June 2008. The decision of the Technical Program Committee is final.

Tutorial materials must be submitted by 1 September 2008, so that materials can be prepared for attendees. The conference will handle materials reproduction and transport to the conference site.

One complimentary, regular conference registration will be offered for each tutorial. In addition, an honorarium will be given for the tutorial (to be shared proportionally if there is more than one speaker). Tutorial presenter(s) are responsible for their travel expenses.

A tutorial may be cancelled due to low pre-registration. The complimentary conference registration will be honored in any case.
